The Beginning

I'm looking for a partner in ministry with whom to start where we are and build. At first, responsibilities will include Sunday and Holy Day organist duties (prelude, hymns, congregational mass settings, postlude). We are a congregation that has shrunk and is growing – mainly with families with young children. We have a Nursery School and a Dance School (serving congregation members and the wider community alike) and a neighborhood that is rich in resources and potential into which we have begun to tap with success even during the pandemic.

The Vision

I am looking immediately, with you, to begin raising extra funding for an adult quartet to form the nucleus of a choir and to look at what it might be to create an after-school music-school to include a choral program that would feed a treble and/or soprano section of the Sunday choir.

The Finances

Compensation would be consistent with the AAM guidelines for the work described and would grow as, together, we build the program and funding. (e.g. tuition derived from a Music School, etc.)
